Large inguinal hernia containing nondilated bowel loops.

CT left Hip without contrast

Clinical Indication

left hip fracture

Technique

Unenhanced axial CT images of the left hip with multiplanar reformats. 3-D construction images were added.

Comparison

In correlation with the same day pelvic x-ray.

Impression

There is an acute displaced subcapital left femoral neck fracture with mild cranial and posterior displacement of the distal femur shaft.

The pelvic ring is intact.

Mild hip joint effusion.

Mild spondylosis of the visualized lower lumbar spine.

Extraskelatal findings:

There is a large right inguinal hernia containing nondilated small bowel loops.

Non-complicated colonic diverticulosis.

Atherosclerotic disease of the visualized iliac and femoral arteries.
